# Oxytetracycline Broiler Chicken Ration for Reduction of Mortality Due to Air Sacculitis Type C Medicated Feed

For reduction of mortality due to air sacculitis (air-sac-infection) caused by <u>Escherichia coli</u> susceptible to oxytetracycline.
